How to Make a Spoon Puppet

What you need:

- 1. Paper (Coloured or white for colouring in)
- 2. Templates for Clothes
- 3. Wooden spoons
- 4. Pipe cleaners
- 5. Crepe paper
- 6. Stickers (for eyes and decorating)
- 7. Decorative bits and bobs—for example stickers, pompoms, sequins and tissue or crepe paper.



Tools:

- Scissors
- Glue sticks
- Sticky tape
- Felt pens

How to Make a Spoon Puppet

- 1. Colour in and cut out the template for the clothes. Make sure you don't cut along the folded end.
- 2. Wrap a pipe cleaner around the 'neck' of the spoon to make arms.
- 3. Cover the handle of the spoon with glue and stick the clothes on.
- 4. Secure with some sticky tape over the shoulders if needed.
- 5. Use crepe paper to make hair (you could also add a hat if your character needs one)
- 6. Draw a face on your puppet using felt tip pens (you could also use stickers).
- 7. Decorate your puppet using pens, stickers, pompoms, sequins and tissue or crepe paper. You could also make shoes, legs or hands using paper.




















Template for spoon puppet clothes

Cut out the hole for the spoon to be inserted into.


